International Quilt Competition for Innovative
Journal Quilts to Tour Britain

Theme:

Home

Important: Entries must measure 21cm x 29.7cm (A4), you must enter two quilts (or multiples of two), and the quilts must consist of 3 layers. You can use any fabrics and any techniques you like.

One entry form required for each pair of Journal Quilts

1st Prize:

A trophy for you to treasure and a stash of wonderful fabrics

2nd Prize:

A bundle of fabrics to add to your stash

3rd Prize:

A bundle of fabrics to add to your stash.

Rosettes awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd places, plus 3 runners up

Open to quiltmakers worldwide for two Journal Quilts (or multiples of two), based on the theme 'HOME'.

Important: This is a Journal Quilt competition so the quilts **MUST** measure 21cm x 29.7cm (A4) each, either portrait or landscape. Each quilt must have a 3" hanging sleeve at the back.

Work is to be of an original and innovative design, or if the design is based on something from a book, magazine, etc., this must be acknowledged. The quilt should constitute three layers of a textile sandwich. You must enter two quilts, which may or may not be related, depending on your preference. One entry form is required for each pair of quilts you enter. You can enter as many times as you like. Please do **NOT** join these two quilts together, they must be separate A4-sized pieces of work.

Completed entry forms should arrive by 17th October 2022 accompanied by a non-returnable entry fee of £13.00, which will include return postage to UK addresses. (Overseas entries will be charged full return postage - cost TBC). Labels will then be sent to all entrants and entries will be required to arrive with Grosvenor Shows Ltd. by 4th January 2023.

All entries will be judged and will go on tour at Newark, Ardingly, Harrogate Spring, Duxford Spring, Exeter & Quilts UK Malvern, subject to space availability.

The judges' decision is final. Acceptance of an entry assumes the grant of permission by the maker for the quilt to be photographed.

DATES:

17 October 2022: Closing date for entries.

21 November 2022: Notification to competitors with labels.

4 January 2023: Entries **MUST** arrive with Grosvenor Shows Ltd. by this date.

January 2023: Entries are judged and winners announced.

January, February, March, April and May 2023: Journal Quilts tour with Grosvenor Shows Ltd. For details of dates, please contact Grosvenor Shows Ltd. Display is subject to space availability at Quilts UK.

June 2023: Quilts returned to quiltmakers.
