### Workshop 1

#### **Russian Dolls *by Gilli Theokritoff***

In this workshop you will make a trio of Matryoshka dolls, whose aprons act as storage for a smaller doll. Made from felt and patterned fabric, these dolls are embroidered in simple stitches - blanket stitch, running stitch and daisy chain and their eyes can be stitched. They would make charming gifts or can be turned into hanging ornaments or key rings, etc. Suitable for all abilities.

#### **Intro to Manx Log Cabin *by Fiona Burrows***

Learn a traditional hand quilting technique and make a small block using just fabric, needle and thread.

#### **Embellished Initials *by Gilli Theokritoff***

You will learn an unusual method of applying fusible web to applique your fabric initial, so that the alphabet letter does not need to be reversed. This can be a revelation and creates lots of possibilities for future use! Once applied your letter(s) can then be embellished and embroidered and used in a pincushion, gift tag or part of an alphabet project. Suitable for all abilities

Create a needlecase using English paper piecing. Kit provided.
