Theme:

Improv Quilting

Important: Entries must measure 21cm x 29.7cm (A4), you must enter two quilts (or multiples of two), and the quilts must consist of 3 layers. You can use any fabrics and any techniques you like.

One entry form required for each pair of Journal Quilts

Open to quiltmakers worldwide for two Journal Quilts (or multiples of two), based on the theme 'Improv Quilting'.

Important: This is a Journal Quilt competition so the quilts MUST measure 21cm x 29.7cm (A4) each, either portrait or landscape. Each quilt must have a 3" hanging sleeve at the back.

Work is to be of an original design, or if the design is based on something from a book, magazine, etc., this must be acknowledged. The quilt should constitute three layers of a textile sandwich. You must enter two quilts, which may or may not be related, depending on your preference. One entry form is required for each pair of quilts you enter. You can enter as many times as you like. Please do NOT join these two quilts together, they must be separate A4-sized pieces of work.

Completed entry forms should arrive by 16th October 2024 accompanied by a non-returnable entry fee of £15.00, which will include return postage to UK addresses. (Overseas entries will be charged full return postage - cost TBC). Labels will then be sent to all entrants and entries will be required to arrive with Grosvenor Shows Ltd. by 3rd January 2025.

All entries will be judged and will go on tour at Newark, Ardingly, Newton Abbot, Duxford Spring, Wetherby & Quilts UK Malvern, subject to space availability at some venues and venues are subject to change.

The judge's decision is final. Acceptance of an entry assumes the grant of permission by the maker for the quilt to be photographed.

DATES:

16 October 2024: Closing date for entries.

22 November 2024: Notification to competitors with labels.

3 January 2025: Entries MUST arrive with Grosvenor Shows by this date.

January 2025: Entries are judged and winners announced.

January, February, March, April and May 2025:

Journal Quilts tour with Grosvenor Shows. For details of dates, please contact Grosvenor Shows. Display is subject to space availability at some venues.

June 2025: Quilts returned to quiltmakers.
